Week 5 | 10.12.25

1 Corinthians | A Jesus Community

Scripture:

1 Corinthians 4:1-13

Discover

1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the passage, what stands out to you? Please share a phrase, theme, or verse.

Learn

3. Paul urges the readers of this letter to regard him and others as "servants of Christ" or "servants for the sake of Christ." What does it look like to be a servant of Christ? Give some small examples and some large examples of being a servant of Christ.
4. We read that we are not to judge one another, because it is the Lord "who will bring to light the things now hidden in darkness and will disclose the purposes of the heart." How does it feel to read this statement when thinking about judging yourself or someone else?

Live

5. Reading again verses 10-13, in what ways are you a fool for Christ? What would you be willing to give up to serve Jesus or to be a fool for Jesus?
6. What is the particular invitation of God to me or to our group through this week's passage or sermon?
