

1 Corinthians | A Jesus Community

Scripture:

1 Corinthians 4:14-21

### Discover

1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the passage, what is it that stands out to you? Please share a phrase, theme, or verse.

### Learn

3. Paul urges the readers to imitate him. What about his life did he want them to imitate? What kind of life might they be living, if not imitating Paul's kind of life?
4. In reading this week's passage and in First Corinthians so far, would you have wanted Paul to "father" and/or "guide" your life personally and our ZPC life corporately? Why or why not?

### Live

5. In verses 19-20, Paul speaks of talk and power. At times, it is easier to talk about doing something than it is to act on it (with power). What might you practice this week to "walk the talk" with power in your life with Jesus?
6. What is the particular invitation of God to me or to our group through this week's passage or sermon?
