1 Corinthians 8:1-13

Discover

1. What is the most important thing we should know about you today or this week? Or what was a high or a low of the past week for you?

2. In your group, discuss the meaning of the sentence: "Knowledge puffs up, but love builds up." Read verses 1-3 for context.
3. In your group, discuss the meaning of the sentence: "But take care that this liberty of yours does not somehow become a stumbling block to the weak." Read verses 9-12 for context.
4. If there is only one true God, why is the issue of idol worship so powerful in the Corinthian context? What are some idols we have today or some similar issues to not eating meat sacrificed to idols in our culture?

5. Have you experienced a time or a person where knowledge was not rooted in love? Describe that experience or person.
6. What is the particular invitation of God to me or to our group through this week's passage or sermon?
