Week 8 | 11.2.25

1 Corinthians | A Jesus Community

Scripture:

1 Corinthians 9:1-27

Discover

1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week? Or what was a high or a low of the past week for you?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the passage, what is it that stands out to you? Please share a phrase, theme, or verse.

Learn

3. What are some of the reasons Paul provides for why he preaches the gospel? What are his rewards for doing that?
4. Paul notes that he gave up some of his rights, even his right to be paid, to preach the gospel. Why did he do this?
5. In verses 19-23, Paul says he makes himself a slave to all to win as many as possible to Christ. He goes on to say that he becomes all things to all people to save some. What is the danger of this attitude? What is beautiful or wonderful about this attitude of Paul?

6. See verse 12. Paul says he would put up with anything rather than hinder the gospel of Christ. What might you be willing to put up with rather than hinder the gospel of Christ? What might you be willing to do to bring others to Christ?
7. At the end of chapter 9, Paul says it takes strict training, discipline, and self-denial to win the race and get the crown. In order to share the good news, what might you do to train or discipline yourself to be like Jesus in the coming weeks?
