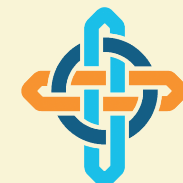

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 10 | 11.16.25 Scripture:
1 Corinthians | A Jesus Community 1 Corinthians 10:23-11:1

Discover

1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week? Or what was a high or a low of the past week for you?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the passage, what is it that stands out to you? Please share a phrase, theme, or verse.

Learn

3. Reading verses 23-26 again, in what ways is a Christian free? From what Paul says, in what ways does it not "feel free" to do whatever you want?
4. Paul says to act in a certain way if an unbeliever asks you to eat with them. Do you act differently around Christians and non-Christians? If yes, why? If no, why?

Live

5. When was a time when you endured pain because of the love you showed someone else?
6. Paul says, "whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God." With your group, consider some ways in a normal day or normal week in which you might give glory to God with your words or actions.
7. In giving guidance to the church at Corinth, Paul finally says, "Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ." It can also be translated: "Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ." Do you have someone in your life you see as an example of Christ? What is one way you might be an imitator/example of Christ to someone else?
