

Scripture:
Matthew 11:28-30

Discover

1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week? Or what was a high or a low of the past week for you?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the passage, what is it that stands out to you? Please share a phrase, theme, or verse.

Learn

3. Jesus says "come to me, take my yoke, and learn from me." Which of these commands is the most helpful for you and why?
4. Jesus says "I will give you rest" and "you will find rest for your souls." What does rest from Jesus look like? Can you put it in your own words?

Live

5. Did you grow up in a family that practiced Sabbath - or do you practice Sabbath now? If you practice Sabbath, what do you do on your day of rest? What is hard about practicing Sabbath?
6. As a Christian, do you feel that Jesus' yoke is resting lightly on you, or are you struggling under it because of the fit? Why?
7. What is one simple way you can find rest or practice Sabbath this next week or in this winter quarter (January-February-March)?
