HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 2 | 1.18.26

1 Corinthians: A Jesus Community

Scripture:

1 Corinthians 11:17-34

Discover

1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week? Or what was a high or a low of the past week for you?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the passage, what is it that stands out to you? Please share a phrase, theme, or verse.

Learn

3. How would you describe the scene if you were at the Lord's Supper at the Corinthian church? Why is it that Paul is strongly correcting the churchgoers and says he has no praise for them?
4. Jesus says in verse 25, "do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." How do we remember Jesus in the Lord's Supper? In the sermon, what was said that could be the opposite of remember?

Live

5. In verse 28, Paul says we should examine ourselves prior to partaking of the Lord's Supper. Do you ever spend time examining how you are doing in your spiritual life? Do you ever "judge yourself" (verse 31) so that you might not come under judgment by someone else?
6. Finally, share with your group how you might look differently at the Lord's Supper after studying this passage and/or this week's worship.
