

Week 3 | 1.25.26

1 Corinthians: A Jesus Community

Scripture:

1 Corinthians 12:1-11

Discover

1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week? Or what was a high or a low of the past week for you?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the passage, what is it that stands out to you? Please share a phrase, theme, or verse.

Learn

3. Who is the source of spiritual gifts and what is the purpose of the gifts? Reflecting on these truths, how does that affect how you might look at your own gifts?
4. Have you seen spiritual gifts used in a way that seems to elevate the person with the gift rather than the gift-giver? How might we as followers of Jesus make sure that particular gifts are not elevated?
5. When was a time when someone with a "quieter" spiritual gift helped to shape you?

6. If you have taken a spiritual gifts test or have just been aware of your own gifts, what would you say is one or two gifts you have?
7. When have you felt that you were part of a team where all the parts worked together for a common goal? How have you used a gift for the common good?
