

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 8 | 3.1.26

1 Corinthians: A Jesus Community

Scripture:

1 Corinthians 15:1-11

Discover

1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week? Or what was a high or a low of the past week for you?
2. Please read the passage (1 Corinthians 15:1-11) aloud in your group. As you hear the scripture, what stands out to you? Please share a phrase, theme, or verse.

Learn

3. Paul speaks in verse 2 of the good news "through which...you are being saved." He says in verse 3, "Christ died for our sins." What does the good news that Christ died for our sins and that you are being saved mean to you?
4. Why do you think Paul went into such a detailed list of who saw Jesus after he was resurrected?

Live

5. Paul says in verse 9-11 that he was the least of all the apostles, unfit to be called an apostle, but "by the grace of God, I am what I am." Do you ever wrestle with receiving God's grace or your "worthiness" of being a follower of Jesus? How does God's grace through Jesus speak to you?
6. While the resurrection of Jesus occurred in the past and while it gives us peace about the future, in what ways do you see it shaping how you live in the present?
