

1 Corinthians: A Jesus Community

Scripture:

1 Corinthians 12:34

Discover


1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week? Or what was a high or a low of the past week for you?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the scripture, what stands out to you? Please share a phrase, theme, or verse.

Learn

3. What do you remember about the first time you experienced death? What impact did that have on you?
4. Paul says that if Christ has not been raised, preaching is useless, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins. How does this sound to you? Does it make you think more about resurrection and/or your own faith?

Live

5. Paul states in the middle of this passage that Jesus' resurrection did happen and so in Christ, all of us who believe will be resurrected too. How does it make you feel that in the end Jesus will win?
6. What is one way in which you can "practice resurrection" today? How does this act describe Paul's words, "Where O death is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?"
