



HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 10 | 3.15.26

1 Corinthians: A Jesus Community

Scripture:

1 Corinthians 16:1-12

Discover

1. What is the most important thing that we should know about you today or this week? Or what was a high or a low of the past week for you?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the scripture, what is it that stands out to you? Please share a phrase, theme, or verse.

Learn

3. Why do you think it is important for the church in Corinth to take up a collection for the church in Jerusalem? When it comes to being generous, how does your own generosity shape you?
4. Why does Paul ask the church to welcome Timothy? What do you think Paul is worried about?

Live

5. In this long letter, is there one theme or lesson that you will take with you? Paul teaches about division in the church, about making choices that honor others (not eating food sacrificed to idols), about marriage, about the Lord's Supper, about spiritual gifts, about love over all, about orderly worship, about resurrection and victory over death. So, what has stood out to you in this sermon series and study on 1 Corinthians?
6. As we look out a few weeks to Holy Week (Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday and the Last Supper, Good Friday and the Crucifixion, and Easter Sunday and the Resurrection), what gives you pause, makes you reflect, or gives you reason to be excited?
