Week 1 | 4.5.26
Easter Sunday

Scripture:
John 20:1-18

Discover

1. Did you do anything special (high or low) these past two weeks or for Easter? What are you looking forward to this spring?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the scripture, what stands out to you? Please share a phrase, theme, or verse.

Learn

3. Easter morning started in the dark with sadness and some confusion around why Jesus' body was missing. When have you felt sadness or confusion like Mary?
4. Following the previous question, Jesus met Mary in her sadness. When has God met you at a great point of need or despair as Jesus did with Mary in verses 15-18? What did it teach you about God?

Live

5. Reflect on the following words of Frederick Buechner: "It has always struck me as remarkable that when the writers of the four Gospels come to the most important part of the story they have to tell, they tell it in whispers. The part I mean, of course, is the part about the resurrection. They are trying to describe it as truthfully as they can. It was the most extraordinary thing they believed had ever happened, and yet they tell it so quietly that you have to lean close to be sure what they are telling. They tell it as softly as a secret, as something so precious, and holy, and fragile, and unbelievable, and true, that to tell it any other way would be somehow to deny it." Share with the group your thoughts on this quote.
6. What does it mean to be an "Easter disciple" like Mary Magdalene? Who is someone in your life you would describe as an Easter disciple? What have you learned about the faith from him or her?
