Week 2 | 4.12.26

Scripture:
John 20:19-31

Discover

1. What is one thing we should know about you and your life this week? How did you celebrate Easter or Spring Break in your family?
2. Please read the passage aloud in your group. As you hear the scripture, what is it that stands out to you? Please share a phrase, verse, or theme.

Learn

3. Instead of explaining the resurrection, on what did Jesus concentrate when he first appeared to his disciples? What does this say about Jesus' priorities?
4. Read verse 23 again. What do you think it means? Do you find this disconcerting? How might you forgive sins or retain them?

Live

5. Who is a "Doubting Thomas" or "Honest Tom" in your life that is not afraid to ask vulnerable questions about his or her faith? Do they disquiet you? Do they help you?
6. Read verses 30-31 again. Name some miraculous signs that Jesus did. If you were to write a book to tell people that Jesus is the Christ, which signs in your own life would you be sure to include?
