Week 6 | 5.10.26

Resurrection Stories

Scripture:

Acts 1:1-14

Discover

1. What is one thing we should know about you and your life this week? Did you do something this week to celebrate Mother's Day?
2. In these 40 days after the Resurrection, Jesus teaches many things including about the kingdom of God. What kind of kingdom are the disciples looking for in verse 6? Is this a different kind of kingdom than Jesus was talking about in the Lord's Prayer?

Learn

3. What are the two different parts of verse 8? How are they interrelated? Put in your own words what verse 8 meant for the disciples then and for us today.
4. Why do you think the Spirit waited ten days between the Ascension and Pentecost (Acts 2:1-4)?

5. Referring back to the last question, are you in a period of waiting right now? If so, how might God be using this time to change you?
6. Thinking of verse 8, do you have a "Jerusalem" or "ends of the earth" or somewhere in between? Do you feel called to go and be a witness - either as an individual, a group or family, or with the ministry of ZPC?
