# HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 7 | 5.17.26

Scripture:

Hebrews 12:1-3, Nehemiah 12:27-43

### Discover

1. As we finish the last week of Home Group questions for spring 2026, please discuss in your group if you will be taking a summer break, having a special meal or party together, or perhaps continuing to meet in the summer. Thank you for participating in a ZPC Home Group this year!
2. What have you seen in the new parts or renovated parts of the ZPC building that has been interesting or exciting? What part of the building might be the most impactful for the church's future?

### Learn

3. In Nehemiah 12, there is a great focus on music, singers, and choirs – especially in celebration. What helps you celebrate big events or rejoice? What positive role might music play in celebration?
4. In the Nehemiah account of the rebuilding of the wall around Jerusalem, it says in Nehemiah 12:43 that everyone rejoiced and “the sound of rejoicing in Jerusalem could be heard far away.” Can you name a time when you really rejoiced with passion? When was a time that you gave great thanks to God?

### Live

5. Following God and God's plans often takes much longer and has more obstacles than we can imagine at the onset. What is something that God has accomplished through you that took endurance and sacrifice, but resulted in God working through you in a beautiful way?
6. Hebrews 12:1-3 says that we are to “fix our eyes on Jesus” and “run with perseverance.” Put in your own words what it means to fix your eyes on Jesus. Both in our own lives and as a church family, how do you see us keep running to Jesus, now and in the future?
