Week 1 | 9.13.26
The Apostles Creed

Scripture:
Psalm 8

Discover

1. What is the most important thing for us to know about you today?
2. Pray for "ears to hear" from God (Matthew 13:16) and read our passage aloud in your group. As you prayerfully hear this week's scripture, what word, phrase, or theme stands out to you?

3. Apart from affirming the existence of God, what else is implied by the opening creed statement "I believe in God?" Why would Jesus choose to take time to explain to them what had happened by looking at scripture instead of simply revealing himself to them?
4. What comes to mind when you think of God as Father?
5. How would you help someone with negative earthly father experiences appreciate the fatherhood and true nature of God almighty?
6. Do you find it easier to focus on the "Almighty" aspect of God (transcendence) or the "Father" part of God (immanence)?
