HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 2 | 9.20.26
The Apostles Creed

Scripture:
John 1:1-18

Discover

1. What is the most important thing for us to know about you today?
2. Pray for "ears to hear" from God (Matthew 13:16) and read our passage aloud in your group. As you prayerfully hear this week's scripture, what word, phrase, or theme stands out to you?

Learn

3. Last week we unpacked the statement "I believe in God" noting that it expresses more than "I believe in the existence of God." This week we start with the statement "I believe in Jesus Christ." What is similar within these two statements, and why does the creed express belief in Jesus Christ like it is a second or distinct expression?
4. What do we mean when we call Jesus by the title Christ?
5. The life of Jesus allows us to "see" God. Based on the life of Jesus, what can we know about God?
6. We are told that Jesus is "our Lord" and throughout the New Testament the lordship of Christ in our lives is emphasized. What does it mean for Jesus to be Lord of someone's life? What fears arise within you when you think about Jesus being the Lord of your life? Is there something that helps you experience that fear and yet have the courage to keep inviting Jesus to be Lord of your whole life?
