HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 3 | 9.27.26
The Apostles Creed

Scripture:
Luke 1:26-38

Discover

1. What is the most important thing for us to know about you today?
2. Pray for "ears to hear" from God (Matthew 13:16) and **read this week's passage aloud in your group**. As you prayerfully hear this week's scripture, what word, phrase, or theme stands out to you?

Learn

3. Last week we looked at John 1, which, referring to Jesus, says, "the Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us." What simple and extraordinary things did Jesus do when he was here, in the flesh?
4. If you have ever experienced a mediator helping to resolve a dispute, what qualities made you feel that the mediator understood, respected, and represented both sides fairly? How do those qualities help us understand 1 Timothy 2:5, which says, "for there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus?" How does Jesus' life and experience make him uniquely effective in representing both God to humanity and humanity to God?
5. When you think about Jesus is it easier for you to believe in his divinity or his humanity? Why?

6. Take a few minutes to discuss in what ways Jesus has revealed himself to you in ordinary ways, through ordinary relationships and in ordinary places. What might it look like for you to spend a few minutes each day pondering where you have experienced Jesus in your life?
