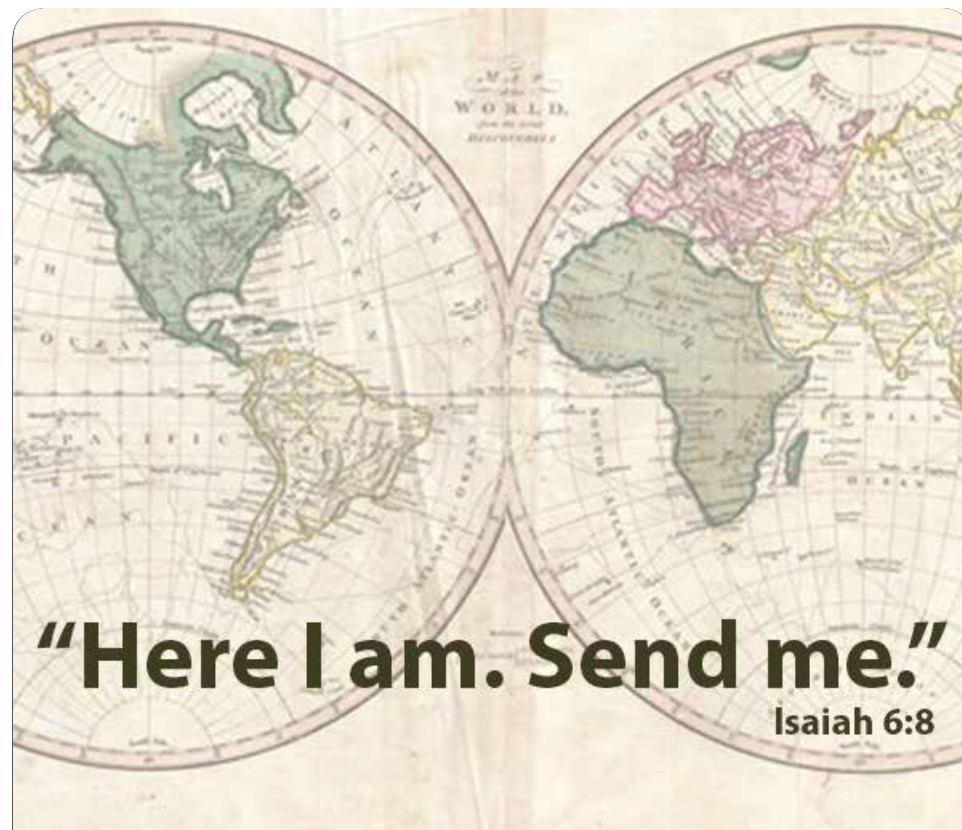

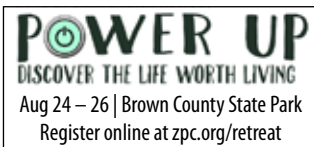
All Church Retreat News Flash!
