Vs. 1-5 - The centurion's slave

He heard of Jesus

- He sent Jewish leaders

- He is worthy

Vs. 6-8 - He sent friends

- Only speak the word

Under authority

Vs. 9-10 - Amazement and healing

Key words/thoughts: slave (δοῦλος); precious (ἔντιμος); send (ἀποστέλλω/πέμπω); save/ heal (διασώζω); encourage (παρακαλέω); worthy (ἄξιος); love (ἀγαπάω); trouble (σκύλλω) faith (πίστις)

Vs. 11-13 - At the gate: a funeral

- A mother's only son

Compassion: Don't weep

Vs. 14-15 - His touch

- "Rise"

- To his mother

Vs. 16-17 - Fear: A great prophet/God's favor

Key words/ thoughts: gate (πύλη); **die** (ἀποθνήσκω); **only-begotten**

(μονογενής); Lord (κύριος); compassion (σπλαγχνίζομαι); bier (σορός); raise (ἐγείρω)

dead (νεκρός)
