Vs. 26-27 - A Gerasene

- He met Jesus

- Demons possessed him

Naked, he lived among the tombs

Vs. 28-33 - Jesus commanded the demon

- The man cried out

- What to me also to you?

Don't torment me

The breaking of chains

- Driven

Legion's pleading/Jesus permitted

Not the Abyss

- Into the swine

- Demon/demons entered

They drowned

Vs. 34- - Swineherds flee

- The Gerasenes saw

Legion clothed and rational

- Fear

- Depart from us

- Jesus to Legion: Go home

Legion "preached"

Key words/ thoughts: Gerasene (Γεργεσηνός); meet (ὑπαντάω); demons (δαιμόνιον); tombs (μνημεῖον); cry (ἀνακράζω); torment (torture) (βασανίζω); unclean (ἀκάθαρτος) seize (συναρπάζω) chains and shackles (ἄλυσις/ πέδη); name (ὄνομα); legion (λεγεών); abyss (ἄβυσσος); swine (χοῖρος); rush (ὁρμάω); drown (πνίγω); self-controlled (σωφροσύνη); fear (φόβος); home (οἶκος);

What motivated the Gerasenes to ask Jesus to leave them?
