Vs. 2-5 Another parable: Injustice

- The judge: neither fear nor respect
- A widow: culturally?
 - She sought justice against an opponent
 - She came repeatedly
- The judge: at first ... and then
 - Self-characterization
 - Either weariness or justice

Vs. 6-8 Jesus' point:

- If an unjust judge ... what of God?
 - He will grant justice
 - Will any remain faithful?
