Chapter 2:

Seek the LORD ... righteousness, humility

- To Gaza (Philistia)
 - The faithful of Judah will possess
- To Moab and Ammon
 - a waste forever
 - To be possessed by Judah's faithful
- To Ethiopia and Assyria
 - possessed by animals (haunts)

Chapter 3:

Defiled Jerusalem

- Her officials
- Her judges
- Her prophets
- Her priests
- She would not
