Vs. 41-47

Jesus now asks:

- **How do you read Psalm 110?**
 - **David wrote: My Lord to my Lord**
 - **Sit to my right**
- **His warning:**
 - **The scribes ...**
 - **robes, greetings, & seats**
 - **consumptions and prayers**
 - **the greater judgment**

Luke 21: 1-4

Vs. 1-4

Jesus observes

- **The wealthy ...**
- **A poor widow**
 - **Two lepton (1/128 denarius)**
 - **Her life ...**

Key words/ thoughts: Lord (κύριος); be ware (προσέχω); walk about (περιπατέω); consume (κατεσθίω); judgment (κρίμα); poor (πτωχός); needy (πενιχρός)
