Vs. 13-27

Two traveling to Emmaus

- **Talking about all these things**
- **Jesus drew near**
 - **Their eyes were closed**
- **What are you discussing?**
 - **Are you the only one who ...**
- **What ...?**
 - **Jesus: prophet/ mighty/ crucified/**
 - **We had hoped ...**
 - **Our leaders killed**
 - **Now third day**
 - **Some women ... no body**
- **Oh! Ignoramuses!**
 - **From Moses and prophets (Handel)**

Vs. 28-32

Their destination: Emmaus

- **Stay with us**
 - **He blessed and broke bread**
- **Their eyes were opened: they saw Him and He became invisible**
- **Hot hearts ... as He opened Scriptures**

Vs. 33-35

Their return to Jerusalem

- **The others gathered w/ the Eleven**
- **He has risen**
 - **He appeared to Simon**
 - **In the breaking of bread ...**

Key words/ thoughts: trial (πειρασμός); **draw away** (ἀποσπάω); **cup** (ποτήριον); **angel** (ἄγγελος); **drops** (θρόμβος); **sorrow** (λύπη); **kiss** (φίλημα); **strike** (πατάσσω); **robber** (ληστής); **sit** (καθίζω); **insist** (ἐπισχύω); **bitterly** (πικρῶς); **prophecy** (προφητεύω); **witness** (μάρτυς)
