- See my hands and feet
 - It is I myself
 - A "spirit" has no ...

- Disbelieving from joy and marveling ...
 - Bread?
 - He ate broiled fish

Vs. 44-49

- Jesus: Scriptures "to be fulfilled"
 - He opened their minds to Scriptures
 - Messiah to suffer

to rise from the dead and repentance and forgiveness

for all the nations

- In Jerusalem first
- You are my witnesses
 - The promise of the Father
 - Stay 'til clothed

Vs. 50-53

Jesus led them ... Bethany

- He blessed them
 - He ascended
- Worshipping ... they returned ... in the Temple
