- Being dead in trespasses and sins
  - In which you walked once
    - According to the age
    - According to its ruler
      - At work in sons of disobedience
        - Among whom we lived
        - By nature children of wrath

Vs. 4-7

But God ...

- Wealthy in mercy vis-à-vis His love
  - We were dead ... together
    - He made alive in Christ
      - By grace you have been saved
    - He raised in Christ Jesus
    - He seated in Christ Jesus
      - in order that it might be evident
        - Excessive wealth of grace in His kindness in Christ Jesus

Vs. 8-10

You ...

- By grace having been saved through faith
  - Faith a gift
    - not works lest someone boast

We ...

- His Poem
  - Created for noble works
    - Prepared by God
      - To walk in them
