Vs. 1-4

A Levite marries a Levite

- She conceives and bears a son
 - She hides him
 - Her daughter watches

Vs. 5-10

Pharaoh's daughter bathes

- She sees basket (among reeds)
 - She pities crying baby
 - Sister: Shall I find a Hebrew nurse?
 - Mother nursed/when grown Pharaoh's daughter raised
 - Named him: Moses

Key words and Thoughts: Levite (מַּבָה); good (טוּב); box (תַּבָה); reed (סוּף); wage (משֹה); pity/spare (חמַל); draw out/save (משֹה);

Ouestions:

- 1. What impresses you most about Moses' birth mother: Her courage, her resourcefulness, her faith?
- 2. From your life, would you relate to Moses' mother, Moses the child, or the Pharaoh's daughter in this story? Who do you see as the greater hero in this passage: Moses' mother, Pharaoh's daughter? Why?
- 3. Pharaoh's daughter hears the crying baby and feels pity for the child and saves the child. What has moved your heart to do something drastic?
