

Vs. 22 - 1:

(Foremen:

- **We're in trouble:**
- **To Moses:**
 - **Yahweh judge you: You're killing us)**

Moses to Yahweh:

- **Why have you brought evil ...?**
- **Where's the deliverance?**

Yahweh to Moses:

- **Wait! With force Pharaoh will them go**

Vs. 2-5:

Yahweh to Moses (remember):

- **I AM ... Yahweh ... I appeared to**
 - **Abraham**
 - **Isaac**
 - **Jacob (and Joseph?)**
 - **They knew me as "God Almighty"**
 - **I established a covenant with them**
- **I have heard ... I remember my covenant**

Vs. 6-9:

- **Say to the people:**
 - **I AM (Yahweh):**
 - **I will bring you out**
 - **I will deliver**
 - **I will redeem (and judge)**
 - **I will take you to myself**
 - **I will be your God**
 - **You will know**
 - **I will bring you to promised land**
 - **I will give it to you**
 - **I AM (Yahweh)**
- **People to Moses: Nope!**
 - **broken spirits and harsh slavery**



Vs. 10-13:

Yahweh to Moses

- Go to Pharaoh
- Let my people go!

Moses to Yahweh:

- But ... They didn't listen to me
- So why would Pharaoh listen?
- "Uncircumcised lips"

Yahweh charged Moses, Aaron, and the people

Key words and Thoughts: Almighty (שדי); deliver/snatch/plunder (נצל); appear (נראה); name (שם); cut (זכר ברית); sojourner (גור); heard (שמע); groans (נאקה); remember (זכר); bring out (יצא); deliver (נצל); redeem (גאל); arm (זרוע); give (נתן); possession/inheritance (מורשה); listen (שמע); short spirit (מקצר רוח); go (בוא); uncircumcised (על);

Questions:

1. By recounting his history with his people, what is God really saying to Moses? Have you ever recounted what God has done for you or how God has remembered his promises to you? If yes, what does that that remembrance do for you?
2. The Israelites would not listen to Moses because of "their broken spirit and cruel slavery" (verse 9). Can you name a time when you felt discouraged or had a broken spirit? What happened and how did you get through that time?
3. When God is at work, sometimes setbacks or suffering comes as the world pushes back on God's good work. Even in the midst of setbacks or suffering, how do we trust God and wait on God to help us?
