




Test Prep Activities Examples

Test Prep Terminology

- Analyze**
Systematically and critically examine each of the facts.
- Compare & Contrast**
Show how the facts or ideas are similar. Show how the facts or ideas are different.
- Define**
Set forth the meaning or make something clear.
- Discuss**
Present a detailed argument or consideration.
- Evaluate**
Determine the value, significance, or worth of.
- Identify**
Establish the essential characteristics of.
- Illustrate**
Make clear by citing examples.
- Interpret**
Present the subject at hand in understandable terms
- Infer**
Draw a conclusion based on given facts; predict, generalize.
- Justify**
Show or prove to be right or reasonable.
- Sequence**
Arrange in meaningful order, beginning to end.
- Summarize**
Explain the main points.
- Synthesize**
Combine the parts into a coherent whole.
- Trace**
Review in detail, step by step.
