This lab will provide a comprehensive introduction to the vital role of the Assistant Director, demystifying the AD's multifaceted responsibilities and showcasing their pivotal role in ensuring smooth and efficient on-set operations.

The program will look at the practical and logistical aspects of the AD's work, including the creation of detailed shoot schedules and call sheets, the management of crew and resources, the diverse responsibilities of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Assistant Directors, on-set communication and protocols and ways to anticipate and address potential challenges.
