Who was Dave Barber?



Dave Barber was the programmer at the WFG's Cinematheque since its inception in 1982. He was a crucial figure in the development of independent cinema in Winnipeg and an outstanding ally to generations of Winnipeg filmmakers. Dave passed away in 2021. On the celebration of what would've been his 68th birthday, we officially renamed the cinema Dave Barber Cinematheque in his honour.
