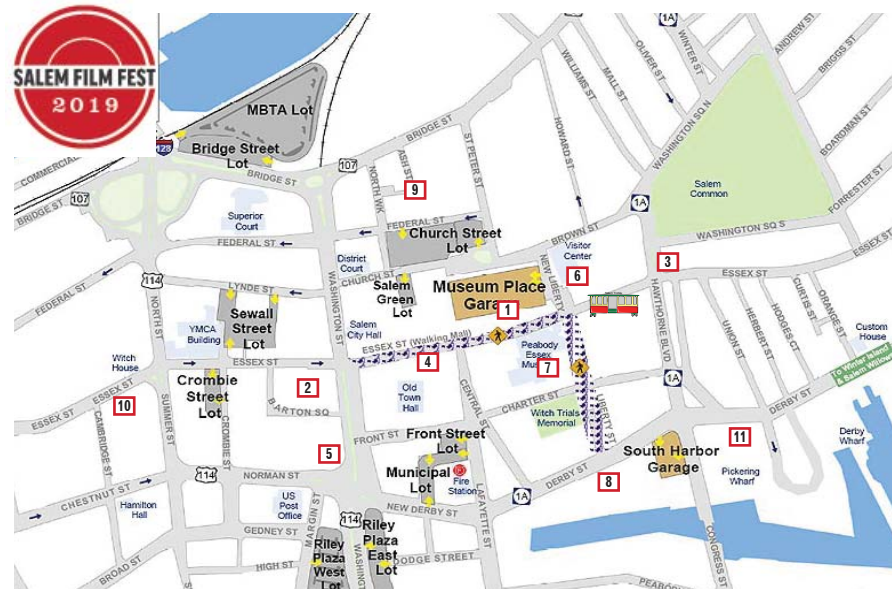
## THE SALEM TROLLEY
