

Reviewing your Footage

EXERCISE

While reviewing your footage, use the log chart on the next page to fill in the necessary information.

If you have experience using video editing software, feel free to do all of your logging in-program.

- the in-point or time-code when the footage or clip starts
- the out-point or time-code when the footage or clip stops
- the duration or the length of time the footage or clip lasts
- comments on the footage with reference to the above points
- if you think the clip is good, include a brief description why

Making these notes on your footage is called “logging”. Based on this information you can now create a sequence of **selects**, or specific sections, of your footage that you want to share.

Note: To upload a file to One Day On Earth, its size must be under 500 megabytes. There is no limit to the number of files you can upload, we only ask that you select the footage that you feel is the strongest and upload it to One Day on Earth. Start to think about how you will break up your footage based on size.
