Admissions Process

Learn:

Apply:

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Once you have decided that you would like to apply, please download or request our application. If you wish to be considered for reduced tuition, please complete the SMART Tuition Aid application. Instructions are included in the school application, and include a \$24 fee to be paid directly to SMART. Once completed, please mail your application to P.O. Box 273, Aquebogue, NY 11931 with a non-refundable check for \$65. If you have applied for reduced tuition, we will be in touch after SMART's assessment has come through.

Meet & Visit:

As the next step, we invite you and your child to meet with the facilitators and administrators of the school to determine if our school is the right fit for your family. Once an application has been submitted, you may schedule a visit for your child, where he/she/they can spend some time in the classroom. The visit offers an opportunity for your family to ask more questions, to get a sense of a day in the life of the school, and for us to learn more about your child.

Enroll:

PCS will consider your application after all materials have been submitted (including records from your current district, if applicable) and your child has visited the school. If PCS has the space and resources to accept your child, we will send you an enrollment agreement. Enrollment agreements must be signed and submitted along with a non-refundable 10% deposit to secure a spot for Fall 2019.

Annual Smart Tuition Payment Processing Fee: \$50 (\$20 for families that pay in full by Aug. 1st)

Peconic Community School believes that families should pay a tuition that is in equitable proportion to their economic resources. As such, the school sets aside a *limited* amount of funds for tuition remission. Families interested in applying for reduced tuition must submit their financial information confidentially to an outside service (SMART Tuition Aid Analysis Program) that calculates an objective independent assessment of financial need. The school will review these worksheets, seek feedback from the family if necessary and then determine a proposed reduced tuition level, if the funds are available. This reduced tuition approach is subject to budget, enrollment and available funds. If necessary, families will be placed on a waiting list until all applications have been fully considered. For further questions regarding tuition and the application process, please call (631) 779-2934.

Please print and complete the application in its entirety. The application may be mailed to P.O. Box 273, Aquebogue, NY 11931 or dropped off in person at 269 Main Road, Aquebogue. A non-refundable \$65 application fee is due upon submission. Checks should be made payable Peconic Community School.
