SACRAMENT OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

INVITATION


PRAYER AFTER THE MEAL

IN WORSHIP

Our final hymn, "Go to the World," was written by the late Sylvia Dunstan (1955 – 1993) while she served as a prison chaplain. The text is based on the theme of the Great Commission in Matthew 28: 19 - 20. God's people compel each other to do two things: first, to go into the world to preach and baptize (stanza 1), and second, to serve as Christ's representatives and servants in the world (stanzas 2 - 3). The final stanza reveals a change of voice – now we hear the direct words of Christ when he promises to be with his church until the end of time.
