### YOUR TIME

Many of you volunteer to support our church or a community mission project. If you have recently volunteered, please complete your entry in this section. Once your entry is completed, bring your passport to church to be processed. A stewardship table will be setup every Sunday in the Gathering Place from 9:30 a.m. - 10:00 a.m., to have your entry stamped and initialed. The "Your Time" category is from June 1st until July 30th. Your total hours worked (not family unit name) will be compiled with other member's hours and this information will be placed in a database to show the number of our volunteerism commitment hours worked for Northminster.

### YOUR TALENT

There are times when we "go the extra mile," to help members in the church or our community, near and far. If you have sent a note or called a friend, or donated money to a charity, we ask you to notate your generosity in the Your Talent section. This is an honor system and once your entry is completed, you may have your entry stamped and initialed in the Gathering Place. A stewardship table will be available every Sunday from 9:30 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. and this category is from August 1st - September 30th. Your honor time hours (not family unit name) will be combined with other member's time and placed in a database to showcase our talent and volunteerism commitment hours for Northminster.

### YOUR TREASURE

You are invited to join us on Sunday, October 30th, Reformation Sunday, for our stewardship dedication Sunday. Members are encouraged to make a monetary pledge to the church. Specific details will be communicated prior to the dedication.
