

THE BIRTH OF JESUS FORETOLD

New Testament Lesson #2

In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, the angel Gabriel (GAY-bri-el) was sent to a young woman named Mary. She lived in the city of Nazareth (NAZ-areth) in Galilee (GAL-i-lee) and planned to marry a man named Joseph. Both were descendants of King David.

When Gabriel spoke to Mary, he said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you."

Mary wasn't sure what to think, but Gabriel told her not to be afraid for she had found favor with God. He explained that she was going to have a baby boy whom she was to name Jesus. Gabriel told her of the great things God planned to do with the child:

- "He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High."
- "The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David."
- "He will reign over the house of Jacob forever."
- "His kingdom will never end."

 But Mary asked, "How will this be, since I am a virgin?"

Gabriel explained that the Holy Spirit would come upon her. He told her that her relative, Elizabeth, who was old and barren, was now in the sixth month of pregnancy. Gabriel explained that nothing is impossible with God. Mary's response was, "I am the Lord's servant. May it be to me as you have said." Then the angel left her.

Mary hurried to visit Elizabeth. When Mary arrived, Elizabeth became filled with the Holy Spirit and blessed Mary for believing God. Mary then praised God for what he had done and was going to do. Mary stayed with Elizabeth for three months and then returned to Nazareth.


POINTS TO CONSIDER:

• Nazareth in Galilee was a region despised by many Jews because of the number of Gentiles living there. The area was called the "Galilee of the Gentiles" in Isaiah 9:1 (around 700 years earlier). In John 1:43-46, when Philip told Nathanael that they had found the one that Moses and the prophets had written about — Jesus of Nazareth — Nathanael's response was, "Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?"


