This is the day when Christ, the bread of heaven, shared a holy meal with his followers, offering a feast of abundant life and grace for all. Let us worship God.





So, forgive us, we pray, because tomorrow will be the same. We will lay you down, and you will rise again. We will pack you up; please don't hide yourself from us. Amen.


ASSURANCE OF GOD'S FORGIVENESS




