A man in East Grand Forks, Minnesota was perplexed to find bullet holes in his home's siding and windows. Police responded to the man's call. They examined the damage before starting to interview neighbors to see if any leads would be uncovered. That is how they met a seventy-six-year-old man who openly admitted to being the shooter. It seemed to the older neighbor as just a minor issue. After all, he was addressing a real menace: squirrels eating at his bird-feeders. He even showed the police his own bedroom window from which the shooting took place. The way he saw it, this was war with those marauding squirrels.

Unfortunately for him, the police did not share his minimization of the shooting and the resulting damage. They arrested the neighbor on the charge of "reckless discharge of a firearm." However, when the shocked older neighbor told his wife that HE was being arrested, she simply replied: "Well, I told you" [Grand Forks Herald, 12/9/2022].

When confronted by the Corinthian church's breaking apart into various divisions circling around their favorite preachers, the Apostle Paul reminded them that preachers are mere mortals not ranking nearly enough in importance to justify such actions. "Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?" he asked (1 Corinthians 1:13). Preachers are just men. Over the next couple of chapters, he wrote on about the evils of church divisions leading us to this familiar declaration: "I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase" (3:6).

The principle is simple. Only seed that is sown can grow. We do not possess the power to make the seed germinate and grow. We only have the power to sow and water. God's formula works only when we do. We, like Paul, can sow. We, like Apollos, can water. Having done our part, we can trust God to do His. So, let's be sowing the gospel seed and when it blossoms and grows as God has promised we shouldn't be surprised if God says, "Well, I told you!"

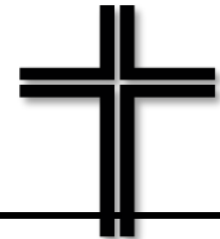
