Some groan when I tell them that in the late 90s and early 2000s I was a big fan of the band Creed. Admittedly their music, and in particular their lead singer's voice, was not great yet their lyrics often hit home with me. As I write this, one song stands out to me. The lyrics go something like this: "When you are with me, I'm free, I'm careless, I believe. Above all the others we'll fly this brings tears to my eyes. My Sacrifice."

I do not know who the band had in mind when they wrote this song but when I think of it today I can not help but think of our savior, Jesus, and the emotions that His sacrifice brings about in me. Can you see the connection? When Jesus is with us, and we are with Him, there is freedom from sin and from the cares that are associated with sin.
