“I never thought it would happen to me” is a statement that is often heard by victims of significant natural disasters, and in particular high impact storms, in their aftermath. I vividly remember watching interviews of individuals after Hurricane Andrew hit South Florida and the same is true after Hurricane Katrina hit the Gulf Coast, especially in the New Orleans area. Even though we witness the hardships that others go through in their lives we are often guilty of thinking that the same will not happen to us.

This is not only true in our physical lives, but also in our spiritual lives. Speaking from experience, I never anticipated that I would be someone who would go through the challenges of divorce. I watched other kids my age endure the challenges of their parents separating, but never believed that I would be involved in a relationship that would head down such a path. I never thought that it would happen to me and yet it did, and I was not prepared.

I am sure each of us have similar stories, though the circumstances may vary. Spiritually, we should never be unprepared for the storms that come in our lives. Peter expresses that Christians should not be surprised at the “fiery trial” when it comes upon us (1st Peter 4:12) revealing that the Christian life is one we should expect to be filled with storms. Jesus expresses a similar truth when he warns those that who were considering following Him that “foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head” (Matthew 8:20).

The life that we have been called to live is not one that is guaranteed to be easy. Yet the reward is great if, when the storms of life come, we are prepared and can overcome them. We must be ready, and never let it be said that “we never thought it would happen to us.” They will. But thanks be to God that we have a savior who “is with you always, even to the end of the age.” Through both sunny and stormy days. Through the valley of the shadow of death. Storms will come.
