Without being too political I think we can all acknowledge that cancel culture is prevalent in our society today. In some ways, oddly enough, this has been beneficial in that it has forced people who might otherwise be tactless to be more cautious and thoughtful about the words that they use. On the other hand the motivation behind cancel culture is not one that is purposeful in seeking out more thoughtful speech, but rather an effort to silence those who go against the grain so to speak.

Recently the unfortunate, and quite scary, events that surrounded Damar Hamlin during an evening football game led to the tv broadcast showing players praying for their critically injured teammate. Commentators and pundits could be heard sending out “thoughts and prayers” to the player and his family. For a moment in time, it was nice to see those actions praised rather than being condemned.

The simple truth for the Christian on a day-to-day basis in this country is that our faith, and our way of life, is under attack. The reason for this? Often, we point to symptoms. We point out that the country is turning from God or that the traditional standard of morality is being vilified as hateful. We even recognize that public school systems are teaching anti-Christian doctrines and beliefs. These are all symptoms of the problem. Satan is the problem. Satan is the enemy. Satan is the source of these things, and he is quite gifted at what he does.

When diagnosing the problem, it is important for us to also be aware of the solution. The solution is not turning back to God, restoring a traditional standard of morality, or returning God to our schools. Those are the results of the solution. The solution, at its core, is for hard fighting Christian soldiers to confront the problem at its source and to wage spiritual warfare against him with everything that we have. If we do this, everything else will fall into place.
