Tryphon, age 11, and Thanos, 6, were playing with their favorite ball on Evgatis Beach, located in the Greek island of Lemnos, when the ball was kicked into the sea. That was on June 30, 2022, and the two brothers were forced to watch helplessly as their ball was swept away on the currents.

Ten days later, a man identified only as Ivan was swimming off Greece's Cassandra Peninsula when he was caught in a riptide and swept out to sea. Immediately the Greek Coastguard was contacted, but after an intense search all hope was lost, and Ivan was declared lost at sea.

Somewhere in the hours after Ivan was last seen he saw something bobbing on the water's surface and began swimming towards it. Eighty miles from where Tryphon and Thanos last saw their favorite ball, Ivan embraced it and held on for dear life until he was spotted by a Greek Air Force helicopter and rescued. I can only imagine the joy of Tryphon and Thanos' mother as she saw Ivan on TV telling of his amazing rescue and holding what had become HIS favorite ball. Imagine the joy!! (Greek Reporter)!
