There is something pure about listening to a child pray. One of the blessings of working as a staff member at church camp is that there are times when you will get to overhear funny conversations or, in this case, the purity in which a young child speaks to the Father in heaven. I recall listening to a little boy pray and after he had thanked God for the food he was going to eat, he began thanking Him for the lights in the ceiling, the table that his plate was on, the silverware he had, each person seated around him by name and an endless list of the different things he could see. Those of us around him had quite the chuckle at this little boy's prayer.

But the more I think about it, the more I am convinced that in some ways this is the sort of attitude or "posture" with which we need to approach God. He was not concerned that he might say the wrong thing or use the wrong phrase or word. He was just happy to talk to God and wanted to make sure that he thanked Him for everything in his world at that moment. You see, sometimes as adults we let so many things interfere with our prayer life. We let distractions, frustrations, worries and even being self-conscious get in the way of just talking to God.

The truth of the matter is that if we want to have an effective prayer life we need to let everything else go when we come before His throne and the things we can't let go of need to be given over to Him. Make no mistake about it, roadblocks in our prayer life are just like road blocks on I-40. They slow us down. They keep us from getting where we want to be. Let us learn to overcome these things and draw closer to God, talking to Him with the same attitude as that young boy at church camp.
