Much like during Christmastime, most of the world is thinking about Jesus of Nazareth. Frequently members of the church push back on the celebration of both Christmas and Easter because they are not Biblically commanded days of remembrance. It is true that Jesus has instructed us in the way which he desired to be remembered, that being the observance of the Lord's Supper which memorializes His work at the cross in the sacrifice of His body (Luke 22:14-26).

Yet is it ever a bad thing when the minds of the world are directed in some way toward Christ? The truth is that we should rejoice when anyone who has not taken hold of the great gift that has been given to us through Christ is reflecting on His death, burial and resurrection. In fact, during the Easter holiday season the minds of countless individuals are focused on what makes the Christian faith so significant and special. Paul illustrates by reminding us that if Jesus did not overcome the grave, then Christians are among the most pitiable of all men because we have bought into a lie (1st Corinthians 15:14-19).

It is the resurrection of Christ that gives the Christian faith meaning and power. Because Jesus rose, we have confidence that one day we may rise to live eternally with Him in heaven. Without the resurrection, what hope is there? Let us take advantage of the great hope that exists and the fact that the world is thinking about it now. Let us not be critical of those who do not yet know, or understand, all that there is to know about what God expects of us.

While in Philippians 1:15-18 Paul speaks about how some preach out of rivalry, envy, selfish ambition and with false motives there are others who do so out of goodwill but with true motive. And at the end of the day what was most important to him was that Christ was preached, and he rejoiced because of it.

Let us rejoice, also, that the eyes of the world are upon Christ today and pray that we may use the opportunities to teach truth and expand the boundaries of the kingdom. **Andrew Beasley**
