Father Knows Best

During the 1999 graduating ceremony at MIT, their president, Charles M. Vest, related how famed electrical engineer Charles Proteus Steinmetz was once called in as a consultant for General Electric. They were facing a complex problem with a huge electrical generator. He disappeared into the generator's room for days, and then just walked off the premises. Confused, the engineers entered the room to find a large chalked "X" on the generator's casing and a note with simple instructions to fix the problem. The executives were shocked when he submitted his \$1,000 bill. When asked for a more itemized invoice Steinmetz submitted: "Marking chalk "X" on side of generator: \$1.00. Knowing where to mark chalk "X": \$999.00."

Godly, Christian fathers are perfectly placed by God to fulfill His purposes (Ephesians 5:25; 6:4). The godly father will have a rich and growing knowledge of God's Word, and by their life experiences (learning from both their successes and their failures) to teach and lead their children.

The same is also especially true when it comes to God our Father. The One who formed our inward parts and covered us in our mother's womb (Psalm 139:13) knows not only us but how we should live to serve Him now and live with Him hereafter. God numbers the very hairs of our head (Luke 12:7). He is the ultimate source of wisdom. He knows. Let's learn from Him.
