Today, as we honor our fathers, I want to provide a few statistics for you that help to illustrate the importance of a child having a father active and present in their lives. According to the national fatherhood initiative, 85% of young people currently in prison grew up in a fatherless home. 7 out of every 10 children that are housed in state-operated correctional facilities, including detention and residential treatment, come from a fatherless home. 39% of students in the United States, from grades 1-12, do not have a father in the home. A child without a father in the home is 4 times more likely to be living in poverty. 24.7 million children in the United States live in a home where their biological father is not present, which equates to 1 in every 3 children not having access to their biological father. Children who live in a single-parent home are twice as likely to commit suicide. 75% of adolescent patients being treated at substance abuse centers come from homes where the father is absent.

Suffice it to say that there is great significance in the role that a father plays in the life of their child. We are thankful for the fathers who are here this morning who are devoted to the lives of their children. You have a great responsibility placed upon your shoulders but also, you are blessed to have the perfect example of how a father should interact with their children. One might reflect on the relationship with God and Jewish people in the Old Testament as the prophet Hosea uses the imagery of a father raising children (Hosea 11). Fathers might also look to Solomon for guidance and exhortation, with the instruction to be a child's teacher (Proverbs 22:6) and also the one who corrects them and sets them on the right path when they err (Proverbs 13:24).

Just as our Father in heaven is integral in guiding His children on the right path, so are the fathers in the homes of their children today. Today we celebrate and honor you for your diligence, care and hard work. -- Andrew
