There was a time when citizens of the United States could walk around on White House grounds. According to the national archives, on February 22, 1837, then President Andrew Jackson had a 1,400 pound block of cheese delivered to the main foyer of the White House for an open house with thousands of citizens and his staff, where they discussed the issues of the day while carving off slabs of cheddar. Days such as this no longer exist. Now one can barely get a glimpse of the building itself, let alone walk inside and have a conversation with the President and his staff.

It is a special privilege to be able to have access to a ruler, and for Christians we have the greatest access that one can have. The psalmist in our scripture declares that both the eyes and the ears of the Lord are upon the righteous. Another way of saying it? God pays attention to us, and He is there listening when we seek Him. Paul expresses that if we do our part and reach out to Him, then He will do His part, and both listen and provide beyond compare (Phil. 4:6-7). What more can one ask for than to have the attention of the One whose thoughts and ways are higher than our own (Isa. 55:8-9) and who gets it right every single time?
