## THOUGHTS ON ELDERS

Being an elder in the church is a good work (1 Tim.3:1). It certainly is not an easy work. But it is God's plan to have men serving in this capacity.

There are necessary qualities listed in 1 Timothy 3 and Titus 1 for any man desiring to serve as an elder. These qualities, given by God, include two traits that each elder must exhibit in order to be effective in this good work.

An elder must have <u>knowledge</u> of the Bible and his congregation. Regular study of God's Book and personal interaction with the church members are necessary. Then capable teachers can be identified and teaching that meets the needs of all can be designed. Elders need to know every member, from youths to seniors to guide them in their spiritual walk with God.

An elder must have <u>wisdom</u> to make good decisions. There will be pressure from within and without the church. Good judgments must be made. Wisdom is needed to guard the church from false doctrines and to deal with individual problems. Wisdom is needed when listening to sound advice from others who may have more experience in a particular area.

Knowledge and wisdom go together and help make an elder effective in His service to God.
